- 7. She got the job **<u>although</u>** she lacked the necessary qualifications.
- 8. She forgave him **<u>because</u>** he apologized sincerely.
- 9. She forgave him **<u>because of</u>** his sincere apology.
- 10. You must do <u>as</u> I say.
- 11. I am here **<u>as</u>** a customer.
- 12. He left **<u>before</u>** the arrival of the storm.
- 13. He left **<u>before</u>** the storm arrived.
