Grammar: ✦ Relative Clause with 'who'

A: We're going to earn a commission from this house soon. Let's celebrate.

B: Really? How come?

A: Remember that last call we got yesterday?

B: Ummm....

A: A woman called and asked about this house. She really wants to buy it.

B: So, the woman who called yesterday wants to buy this house.
