The man who called yesterday wants to buy this house.

The man who(m) I called yesterday wants to buy this house.

Grammar: Relative Clause with 'who' and 'whom'

The man wants to buy this house. + He called yesterday. The man wants to buy this house. + I called him yesterday.

There was a one-year guarantee which came with the TV.

Grammar: Relative Clause with 'which'

There was a two-year guarantee.	+	It came with the TV.
